

The minutes from the ESROC meeting 2001 in Uden

1. Attending countries: CZE, FIN, GER, NL, SUI, SVK, SWE.
2. The ESROC European Championships will be raced in Seinäjoki, Finland in September 20.-22. The ESROC European Team Championships will be raced in Baar, Switzerland.
3. The World Championships (Gp.7, Gp.27) will be sanctioned by ESROC and ESROC rules will be used.
4. The ESROC European Team Championships location and time will from now on be decided in the previous year's team race, not at ESROC meeting.
5. It was informed that ESROC, NPRA (Brazil) and USRA (USA) have agreed on a 3-year rotation of the World Championships. In 2000 the race was in Brazil, in 2001 in USA and in 2002 in Europe (Pilsen, Czech Rep.).
6. Due to the Sept.11 events last year, the Brazilian Champion José Mario Serra will also be invited to the ESROC 2002 race, in addition to the best placed Brazilian racer in the Brazilian Nats 2001.
7. Money 2001: From team race 240DM, from sprint races 720 Hfl. No Brazilians showed so the start bonus of USD500 was not given.
8. The bodies should be detailed in the USRA style. Rules changed to include three race numbers.
9. Three-dimensional driver discarded, new rule says the driver must be detailed.
