## ESROC MEETING 2002 MINUTES

### 1. OPENING THE MEETING

The meeting was opened by the chairman.

### 2. ATTENDING COUNTRIES

### 3. THE 2003 RACE ORGANIZER NOMINEES

- a. TEAM RACE: Pilsen, Cz
- b. SPRINT RACE: Vienna, A

### 4. VOTING FOR THE 2003 RACE ORGANIZERS

#### a. TEAM RACE

**Pilsen** (Slot Racing Club Pilsen, Zdenek Benes) **was selected** (no voting) as the organizer, date is June 27.-29. 2003.

#### b. SPRINT RACE

**Vienna** (Slotracing Center Austria, Stefan Hommel) **was selected** (no voting) as the organizer, date is Sept. 18.-21. 2003. The club has agreed to move the lap-counter to the banking, as per ESROC regulations for new tracks.

### 5. RULE CHANGE PROPOSALS

- a. Move-up system change. Voting: Current system vs. Australian system
- b. Track open at night as long as possible
- c. Paper drivers permitted (must be printed and good looking)
- d. Cars must have painted numbers or number stickers (not written with a pen)
- e. Entry fee will be 30€ in Gp.27 and 35€ in Gp.7. In team race, entry fee will be 30€/ team.

### 6. VOTING FOR RULE CHANGES

### 7. ESROC FINANCE

With the new entry fees, the NPRA incentive can be maintained. **Baar has not paid ESROC its share of the entry fees from the 2001 ESROC team race.**

Will continue as before (\$500 for the best Brazilian in the Brazilian Nats to cover travel expenses if attends the ESROC European Championships).



## 9. MISCELLANEOUS

- a. **ESROC suggests a local race (not a European Championship) type “Semi-Pro” be organized during the ESROC European Championships (on Wednesday or Thursday) for less experienced racers.** It is suggested the top drivers should not attend. Trophies for the best.
- b. Seinäjoki, FIN, applies for the Worlds 2005. Seinäjoki is in danger of losing its track room, so to support the club, As an exception, **Seinäjoki is selected as the organizer of the 2005 Worlds**, the date will be between June 1-15. **If the club should still lose the track room, the organizer will be re-selected in 2003 ESROC Meeting.**
